Qualifications

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Possession of a current Louisiana license to practice professional land surveying.

Job Concepts

Function of Work:

To provide practical application of land surveying theory and skills to a variety of field or office tasks involving standard procedures and practices.

Level of Work:

Experienced.

Supervision Received:

General from a Surveyor 5, Engineer 5 or equivalent level official of the agency served.

Supervision Exercised:

May exercise functional supervision over Surveyor Interns, Engineering Technicians, or other personnel engaged in survey work.

Location of Work:

May be used by any state agency.

Job Distinctions:

Differs from Surveyor Intern 1 and 2 by the responsibility for approving surveys by affixing the required stamp, testifying in court as an expert survey witness, and the requirement for professional licensure.

Differs from Surveyor 4 by the size and scope of assigned work as well as the independence of work.

Examples of Work

May supervise a team of employees engaged in location, property, geodetic, and hydrographic surveys.

Contacts property owners to obtain permission to enter private property.

Performs the mathematical computations necessary to complete the survey.

Reviews the mathematical computations of engineering technicians and others engaged in survey work.

Contacts utility companies to locate underground utilities.

Receives job assignments, assembles crew and equipment at job location, determines best method for conducting the survey, and directs the work of the survey crew.

Researches records in courthouses, land offices, and other locations where maps and ownership records are stored to determine inconsistencies, errors, and omissions in deeds, abstracts, maps, and surveys.

Reviews, approves, signs, and affixes seal to right-of-way maps and plats prepared by subordinates, causing them to become legal documents.

Acts as an expert witness in court suits involving matters pertaining to land boundaries.

May supervise sub professionals in the analyzing of title abstracts, computations, and preparation of right-of-way and special maps on a project by project basis.
