DUTIES:

10%:

Service. The instructor will engage in service to the department, college, and university. Particularly, they will assist in recruiting and retention efforts, which are crucial to success of the program.

20%:

Research. The instructor will engage in appropriate scholarly activities related to the field. The instructor will help to maintain the Department's connection and collaboration with the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors.

70%:

The instructor will teach 15 contact hours of courses. Primarily, they will be responsible for teaching introductory engineering and geomatics courses. However, they might also teach some upper-level courses.

Other Minimum Requirements:

Background in land surveying, boundary control and legal principles, state plane coordinating systems, route and construction surveying, subdivision design and platting.

Preferred Education:

Master's or Ph.D. in Geomatics, Surveying or closely related field.

Preferred Experience:

The candidate would ideally have hands-on capabilities in field practice and be active in relevant professional societies.

Preferred Licenses:

Professional Licensure in Land Surveying.
