Dear Membership:

Welcome to a New Year, 2022, with hopes of better things on the near horizon. I hope all are doing well and have adapted to "rolling with the flow" regarding the COVID 19 ongoing issues. If we look at it like a new survey, we adapt to the circumstances we are faced with and do our best to work our way through it. Keep up the great work.

I would like to point out that National Surveyors Week is March 20-26, 2022, with Global Surveyors Day being Monday, March 21, 2022. Keep those dates in mind and make an effort to raise the awareness of Professional Land Surveyors in Louisiana. We need more awareness and interest in our Profession to continue all that we do.

Speaking of awareness, there has been recent activity in the latest discussions of previously mentioned "Drone Highways" and continued efforts by the nationwide group, **AUVSI (Association for Unmanned Vehicle Systems International)**. The Louisiana Drone Advisory Committee has been informed of a more recent topic of "Avigation Easements" that may be trying to be introduced as a Federal Law to bypass the States Laws. There was an early mention of a "Toll" associated with the said "Avigation Easement" but has since been dropped, for now. There are still Private Property Owner Rights to be considered. The Drone Advisory Committee has requested Opinions from Louisiana DOTD, FAA, and the Louisiana Attorney General regarding the rights of the Airspace. The stronghold for the AUVSI is "Title 49, Part A, Section 1 of the U.S. Code" which states: "The United States Government has exclusive sovereignty of airspace of the United States". I continue to mention this topic due to the ramifications it could have on the Surveying Profession as it relates to our gathering of data. LSPS will continue to monitor this topic to see what develops and take action if it gets to the point of harming our surveying methods and Profession. Should any of you become aware of any new information, please send to your District Chairman or any LSPS Board Member.

On a more fun note, it is getting close to our 2022 LSPS Convention. I am looking forward to a convention like we had several years ago. Meeting in one place to visit and catch up with our friends and fellow surveyors from around the state. 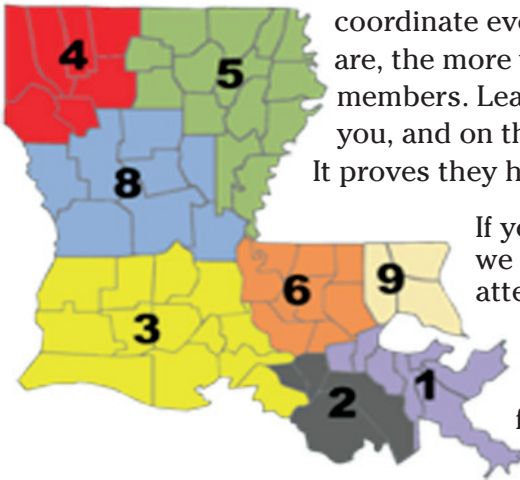

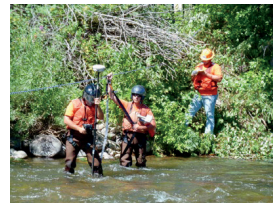
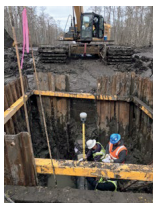

NSRS Modernization News

Well, it's 2022...

...and since many components of the modernized NSRS will have “2022” in their name, NGS anticipates questions about the release date. Despite best efforts, the modernized NSRS will not be released for a few more years. This was formally announced in June 2020 with [this announcement](#).

New Paper

A new paper was released last quarter, relevant to NSRS modernization: [The Mathematical Relation between IFVM2022 as Expressed in ITRF2020 with IFVM2022 as Expressed in the Four Terrestrial Reference Frames of the Modernized NSRS with Dependence on EP2022](#) (Smith, Roman, and McFarland), NOAA TM NOS NGS 90: It documents the equations relating the Intra-frame Deformation Model of 2022 (IFDM2022, formerly called IFVM2022) across ITRF2020, NATRF2022, PATRF2022, CATRF2022, and MATRF2022.

IFVM2022 Renamed IFDM2022

To improve accuracy in nomenclature, NGS—in collaboration with the Canadian Geodetic Survey—has changed the name of the Intra-Frame Velocity Model (IFVM2022) to Intra-Frame Deformation Model (IFDM2022).

Progress in Ongoing Projects

There are currently **33 ongoing projects** related to NSRS modernization around NGS. Here are some highlights:

GVX and OPUS-Projects 5.0 (Project Manager: Dr. Daniel Gillins)

Real-time kinematic (RTK) or post-processed GNSS vectors in [GVX file format](#) can now be uploaded into [Beta OPUS-Projects 5.0](#) for least squares adjustment. Both Trimble and Topcon have released new tools in their software for exporting GVX files. Leica and i-GAGE are also developing GVX exporters. Please collect RTK data on survey marks, export results in the GVX format, and upload the GVX files to Beta OPUS-Projects 5.0 and provide NGS with feedback on the workflow.

Heads up! ***GVX format will be slightly updated in the next 12 months!*** In 2022 NGS will release an update to GVX in a joint roll-out with new formats LVX (leveling) and CVX (angles and distances). The update is driven by a need for greater consistency among the formats.

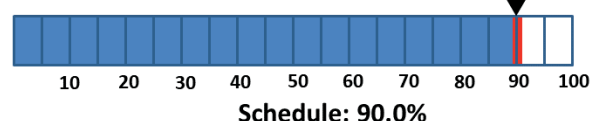
GPS Campaign for Transformations (Project Manager: Galen Scott)

NGS officially extended the GPS on Bench Marks Campaign’s cut-off date by one year to **December 31, 2022**. Partners are encouraged to continue to collect and submit GPS data to NGS for modernizing the National Spatial Reference System.

GRAV-D progress last quarter: **up 1.3% to 90.9%**

The 2022 Louisiana Legislative Session is scheduled to begin on March 14th. As of February 1, 50 bills have been filed. Majority of those regarding retirement systems in the state. The deadline for bills and Constitutional Amendments to be filed is March 2nd. We normally see most bill show up in the system the week of the deadline. The LSPS Board and membership will be notified of any bills of interest as they are filed. Between now and the start of the session we will continue build relations and meet with key legislators and committees. 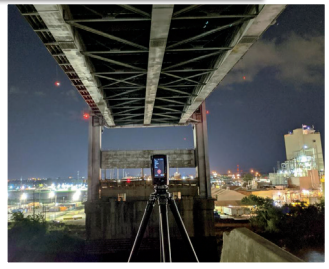

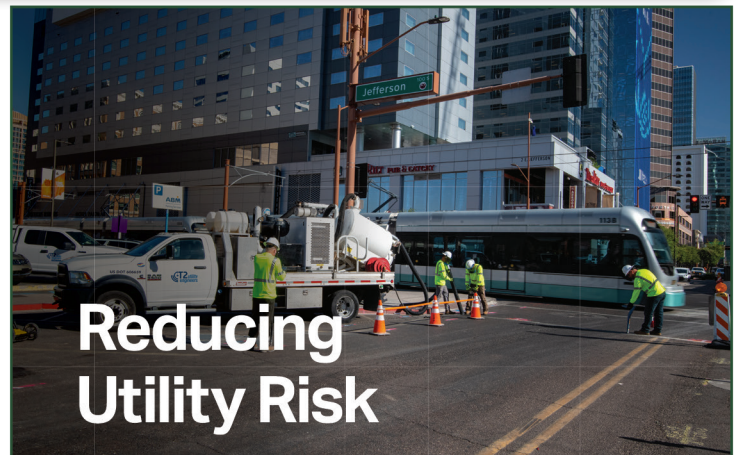

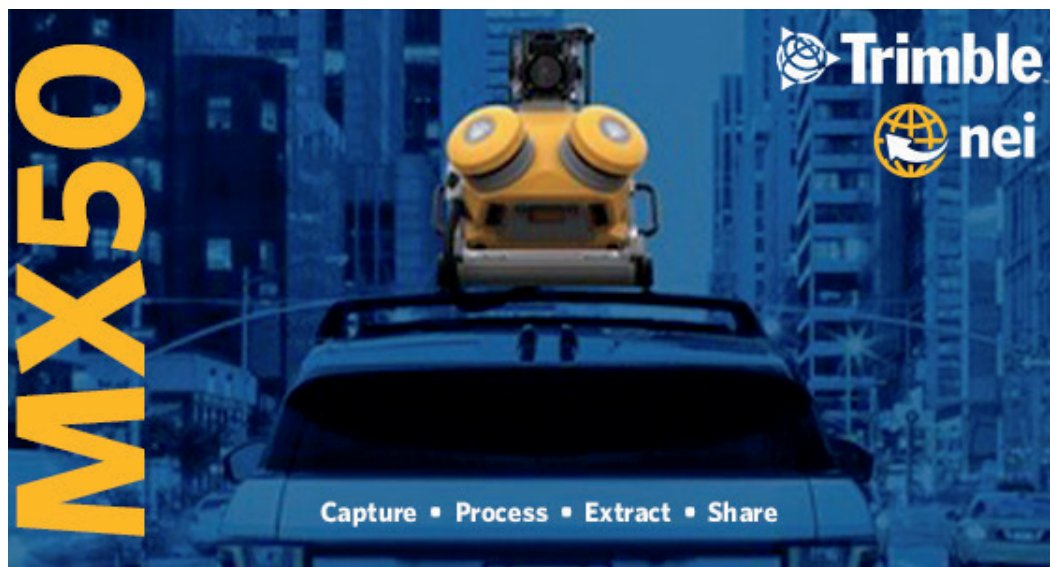
